### "243rd Anniversary Celebration of the Battle at Kettle Creek Held"

"Chapters of the National Society Sons of the American Revolution traveled from all over the southeast to attend the 243rd Anniversary Celebration of the Battle of Kettle Creek on Saturday, February 12, 2022. The event started with the raising of the 13 Star U.S. Flag and a 3-round firing of over 30 flintlocks. Next a parade was held by marching around the downtown square 2 times. At 10:30, all the Elijah Clarke Militia and the Brier Creek Artillery formed on the pasture behind the Wilkes County Courthouse and participated in a re-enactment of the battle at Kettle Creek. We then formed in front of the courthouse and lowed the 13 Star U.S. Flag for the end of the morning ceremony and again fired our flintlocks 3 times. After lunch we moved to the actual battlefield on top of "War Hill" for the 243rd Celebration at 2:30. Many wreaths were presented and then 3 rounds each were fired by the flintlocks, muskets and cannons. Again, the weather was the best that we have had in several years."

"On Friday morning, February 11, 2022, members of the East Fall Line Region traveled to Elijah Clarke to participate in the "Heroes of the Hornet's Nest Event". We arrived around 09:00 to help set up Compatriot Steve Burke's "traveling trunk", 4 tables full of relics and different skins of "road kill". The Brier Creek Artillery also set up our 6-pounder mortar, 6-pounder Naval Gun and our 8-pounder Field Gun. At 11:00 and every 15 minutes we fired our Pennsylvania/Kentucky 50 Cal. rifles, our Brown Bess 75 Cal. Muskets and our Charleville 69 Cal. Muskets, followed by all 3 cannons. At 12:00, we were fed a fantastic meal by Compatriot Jay Guest. At 1:30 the Elijah Clarke event started and during the event, many wreaths were presented followed by flintlock and cannon fire. We have to say that the weather was the best that we have had in several years."

# "Brier Creek hears Sharpshooters program"

"The Brier Creek Chapter, Georgia Society Sons of the American Revolution held its monthly meeting on Thursday night, February 3, 2022 at the American Legion, Sylvania, GA at 7:00. With President Wayne Howard presiding, we had 12 members in attendance. President Wayne opened the meeting with the Pledge to the U.S.

Flag and then the pledge to the Sons of the American Revolution. Then Bernard Martin said the prayer. President Wayne then asked Compatriot Dess Smith III to report on the upcoming 243rd Anniversary Celebration of the Battle at Brier Creek. Dess reported that there will be 3 different events as in the last 6 years. The first event will be the "Education Day Program" that will be held on Friday, March 4th beginning with the first session at 9:00 a.m. at the battle field site. Other sessions that day will be at 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Each session will have 4 stations rotating at about 15 minutes for each station. At the end of each session, there will be a 10-minute re-enactment between the British and American forces. Hopefully students from different schools in the area will schedule their times with the Coordinator, Dess Smith III at 478-299-1039. The second event will be the 3rd Annual Brier Creek Revolutionary War Battlefield Association, Inc's Banquet at the First United Methodist Church beginning at 6:30 p.m. Reservations are needed by calling Dess Smith III at 478-299-1039 by February 21st. The Banquet speaker will be "Jason West" who will be presenting his "Button Gwinnett" impersonation. The third event will be the 243rd Anniversary Celebration of the Battle at Brier Creek. This will be held on Saturday, March 5th at 11:00 a.m. on the Battlefield. This year's speaker will be "Charles B. Baxley, publisher of and co-founder of the Southern Campaigns of the American Revolution. Charles was also the tour guide for the "Francis Marion's War in South Carolina. Charles also was the organizer of the "Southern Campaigns Revolutionary War Roundtable and Corps of Discovery held on February 20, 2016 at Ebenezer, GA. President Wayne then introduced Compatriot Steve Burke and his assistant Bernard Martin. Steve's program was on the "Sharpshooter's Shooter". Steve began by telling us all about the period rifles that he brought for demonstration. The Matchlock 50 cal. musket (1600's), which had a burning piece of rope that would fall onto the powder when the trigger was pulled. The flintlock eventually replaced it. The flintlock (1700's) had a much better ignition system and they came in rifled 50 Cal. barrels, 69 Cal. and 75 Cal. smooth bore muskets that could mount a bayonet for hand to hand fighting. In 1842 the percussion cap was invented to replace the flint on the rifle and smooth bore muskets. The fourth weapon that Steve showed us was the sniper percussion cap smooth bore Whitworth 45 Cal. musket. Our meeting was ended with the Sons of the American Revolution processional and the invocation."





"Brier Creek and Wiregrass Chapters, SAR, attend Wreaths across America"

"Brier Creek Chapter and Wiregrass Chapter members traveled to Sylvania, GA on December 18, 2021 to participate in the "Tribute to the 40 Screven County Veterans" Who never made it home. The tolling of the bell was done in three parts: 17 casualties of WWI, then 22 casualties of WWII and 1 casualty of the Korean War. Including these 40 wreaths, there were a total of 559 wreaths placed in the Screven County Cemetery on veteran's tombstones. This event was Sponsored by the American Legion Screven County History buffs in support of the Ellis E. Williams Memorial Post 7116, Veterans of Foreign Wars George Alexander Mincey Memorial Post 116. Members of the Brier Creek and Wiregrass Chapters, Georgia Society Sons of the American Revolution at the conclusion fired a 3-round volley with their flintlocks. Those members firing their flintlocks from the Brier Creek Chapter were Don Bazemore and Allen Mincey. Those members firing their flintlocks from the Wiregrass Chapter were Wilder Smith, Jr., Steve Burke and Al Smith. Don Bazemore played tapes on his bugle at the end of the ceremony."




## "Derden Presents the Court Martial of MG Ashe"

"The Brier Creek Chapter, Georgia society Sons of the American Revolution held its monthly meeting on Thursday night, November 4, 2021. With President Wayne Howard presiding, we had 20 members and guests in attendance. After the invocation and pledges, President Wayne introduced Samuel Bazemore to our chapter. Samuel is our newest member and is the son of Compatriot Adam Bazemore and grandson of Compatriot Don Bazemore. With both of them looking on, President Wayne inducted Samuel into the Brier Creek Chapter. President Wayne then called on the Wiregrass President Wilder Smith, Jr. to introduce the speaker for tonight. President Wilder introduced Compatriot Dr. John Derden, Historian for the Wiregrass Chapter and retired History Professor from East Georgia State College. John's program tonight was on "The Court Martial of Patriot Major General John Ashe", the commander of the North Carolina Patriot forces and state troops from 1776-1779 was the commander at the Battle of Brier Creek, March 3, 1779. He resigned from military service after the Patriot defeat at the Battle of Brier Creek in 1779. At the Battle of Brier Creek, Colonel Mark Prevost, commander of the British force, approached the Patriots camp from the rear on March 3, with Ashe's force having just 15 minutes notice to prepare for the onslaught. Ashe's poorly trained and supplied militia were routed, with an estimated 150 casualties compared to around 16 British casualties. Ashe was subjected to a court martial, which found that although he was not entirely to blame for the debacle, he was guilty of setting inadequate guards around the camp."
